- 3. Help them make a plan : This will help in progressing in an organised way.**
- 4. Keep distractions to a minimum - This means no TV, loud music, or phone calls. (Occasionally, though, a phone call to a classmate about an assignment can be helpful.)**
- 5. Make sure your child does his/her own work : This will help to make them self efficient**
- 6. Set a good example. Be a motivator/mentor. Praise their work and efforts :**
- 7. Plan fun activities after homework. Family game time, watching a favourite show, or heading out for ice cream are all great ways to naturally reward being finished with work. Take them to village/relative's house for outing and let them spend time with their cousins, grandparents to improve their social emotional quotient.**
- 8. If there are problems continuing with homework, get help. Talk about it with your child's teacher.**
